During the early years of our nation, <u>women were not afforded</u> the same rights as men including <u>the right to vote</u>. Under the leadership of *Susan B. Anthony* and many other women's rights pioneers, the suffrage movement began and overcame numerous milestones over the next century. In the year **1920**, through the hard work of the *National Woman's Party (NWP)* and *National American Woman's Suffrage Association (NAWSA)*, women were finally granted the right to vote under the **19<sup>th</sup> amendment**. Fast forward to 1980, President Jimmy Carter had taken the initiative to declare <u>March 2<sup>nd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> National Women's History Week</u>.
