

What is EarlySteps?

EarlySteps provides services to families with infants and toddlers aged birth to three years (36 months) who have a medical condition likely to result in a developmental delay, or who have developmental delays.



The EarlySteps Process

1

HDC Disability Specialist makes referral on behalf of the family.

2

There will be a phone screening with an EarlySteps coordinator.

3

The child will be evaluated in the family's preferred location, such as the home, early learning center, HDC, etc.

4

If the child qualifies, they will receive an Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP).

An EarlySteps evaluation is not a diagnosis.

It is a developmental evaluation to determine if your child is eligible for EarlySteps services.
