Halloween is fun because I get to dress up in a costume and celebrate with others, but I have to remember a few things to keep me safe and help me have a good time!

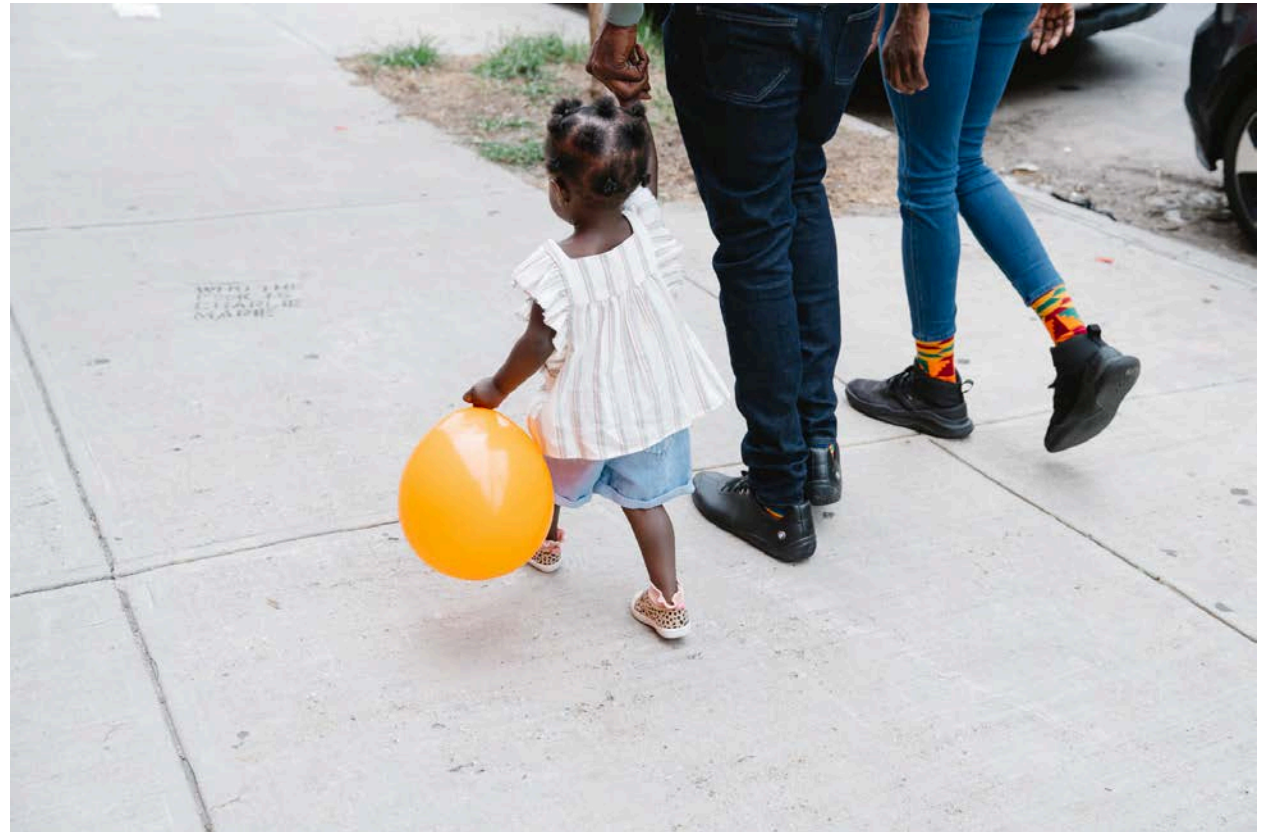


I must stay close with my teacher or family member when going to new places. There will be a lot of people around and I don't want to get lost.
